What Dominion Road School looks like at Alert Level 3-2 for children, staff & families on site - Term 4, 2021

Classrooms	Pick up and Drop Off	School Events
<p>Hand sanitiser, soap & paper towels will be provided in every learning space & common areas</p> <p>Additional disinfectant/cloths are available in all classrooms for teachers to sanitise spaces throughout the school day as required</p> <p>Teachers will clean tables and other surfaces at the end of each day and the cleaners will do another clean on top of that.</p> <p>Sharing of equipment will be carefully managed</p> <p><u>No parents or unnecessary visitors</u> are permitted into classroom spaces</p> <p>Teachers will manage distancing within classrooms as much as is practicable</p> <p>Windows and doors will be open in all rooms for adequate ventilation</p> <p>Each class bubble will be physically separated from other class bubbles and will have their own designated entrances and toilets</p> <p>All students in Yr 4-6 must wear a face covering inside to be able to attend school (unless a medical exemption has been provided)</p> <p>Class bubbles will be arranged by year group levels and will not mix with other class bubbles between 9am & 3pm</p>	<p>All adults, who are not staff, must stay outside the school buildings and not go into classes. The junior playground gate will remain locked during Level 3:2</p> <p>The school bell will go at 9.00am for the start of school and classrooms will not open until then. Please avoid sending your child to school too early to minimise any unnecessary mingling. Please note: the school can not be responsible for children mixing together outside of school hours</p> <p>Children who arrive later than 9.00am will need to check in at the office</p> <p><u>To ensure parents are spread out at pick up time we ask that:</u></p> <p>Takahē parents wait outside the office area on the top court at 3.00pm</p> <p>Tūi parents wait under or near the large shade sail at 2.30pm (office will arrange older siblings to leave class for pick up at this time)</p> <p>Kākāpō parents wait on the bottom courts at 3.00pm</p> <p>We ask all adults in our school grounds to follow physical distancing rules and wear a face covering when on school grounds</p> <p>Any parents who need to collect their child early from school will be asked to come to the office. The office staff will call your children for you</p> <p>Parents are asked to be punctual in collecting their children. If children are walking home they will need to leave immediately at 3.00 & not linger at school</p>	<p>At Alert Level 3:2, congregations or large gatherings of any kind are not allowed at school</p> <p>Any school assemblies will be held online</p> <p>Out of School Care can <u>not</u> operate at Alert Level 3:2</p>
Visitors to School incl. Contractors	Playground & Eating Times	Minimising the Risk of Covid-19
<p>Any visitors (who are not at school to drop off or pick up children) must check in at the school office and wait outside at the main doors until someone comes to you. Please maintain adequate distancing from people around you & wear a mask</p> <p>We are able to take payments for school hats or other requests at the office doors</p> <p>If you need to collect your child earlier in the school day please come to the main doors at office and we will call your child - please do not come inside</p> <p>Covid QR Scanning posters are located around the school. Please use these when coming onto the school site</p> <p>At Level 3:2 there is no preschool visiting but enrolments may take place following health and safety procedures</p> <p>Any contractors onsite during school hours are required to be vaccinated</p>	<p>Children will have staggered break times with their own class bubble in a designated area of the school</p> <p>Takahē and Kākāpō students will be on the field (at separate times)</p> <p>Tūi students will be in the junior playground (at separate times)</p> <p>Good hygiene practice will be observed before and after playing with any equipment</p> <p>Drinking fountains will be open but it is preferable that students bring their own named drink bottle to school</p> <p>Contact sports and games (e.g. rippa, tag) are <u>not</u> allowed</p> <p>Children will be eating outside with their class bubble in a set area, weather permitting. They need to bring their own morning tea & lunch to school</p> <p>The swimming pool, playgrounds and other equipment are allowed to be used</p>	<p>Students who are unwell or who have family members who are unwell <u>must</u> stay at home</p> <p>Any students or staff who become unwell during the school day with cold/ flu like symptoms will be sent home (with any siblings) & asked to seek medical advice (& if required, a negative covid test before returning to school)</p> <p>If you go for a Covid test please remain at home until you get the result</p> <p>Anybody who has been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 must stay at home and self-isolate</p> <p>If there is a <u>confirmed</u> case of Covid-19 linked to the school, we will be notified by the Medical Officer of Health. All parents/caregivers would be notified by the school through text/email. If you have recently changed your email or phone number please let the office know</p> <p>If your child is away from school when they are expected to be here, please let the office know</p>
